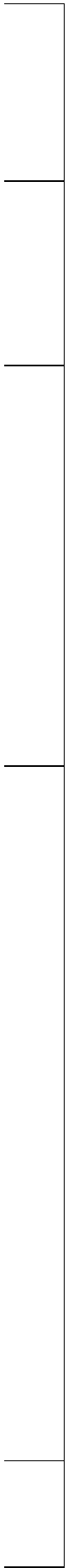

	<p>Parks Plan update – Urban renewal annex of Pleasant Valley and Springwater. City Population is projected to increase to 130,000. The last master plan was crafted in 1996 and was never fully implemented due to funding and politics. There is a new master planning phase that is set for 2008 completion. Ric has done a great deal of community outreach and community surveys are coming in. Two things that came up were skate parks and dog friendly parks. Surveys are being conducted and the deadline for survey return is June 15th. www.ci.gresham.or.us</p> <p>A more detailed survey was sent out to 2000 randomly selected residents and over 400 were returned. The City has also done a focus group with the Hispanic community and focus groups are also planned for the Eastern European community. Ric will plan to attend our August Wilkes East meeting. There is no playground area in East Wilkes; Columbia View was discussed as a possible option for review.
