lan gave us an overview of the work that Habitat for Humanity does in the community. Homes built more affordable, equitable access to homeownership, make vacant, underutilized, and publicly owned land available for affordable housing development.

The new project located on 17640 NE Glisan St., Gresham. Featuring 20 homes with 3, 4, or 5 bedrooms, that will house over 80 people. The community will feature a beautiful green space with mature Douglas Fir trees. These homes will remain affordable for future generations through the community land trust model. Clean Air Action Planning

A kickoff meeting was held at H.B. Lee Middle School and was sponsored by DEQ and Neighbors for Clean Air. The State of Oregon picked several communities to do pilot projects and Rockwood and Wilkes East are two of those areas. They will be looking at all types of pollution and paces to put their recording equipment to collect data.

Janet gave a power point presentation giving us a lot of information about the air quality in our area.
